Consortial Relationship

Chattahoochee Valley Community College (CVCC) provides all of the course work that is necessary for its degree programs, diplomas and certificates. The College does not participate in any consortial relationships to offer educational programs.

Dual Enrollment

Chattahoochee Valley Community College follows State Board Policy [801.04](#) regarding the Dual Enrollment program for High School students, allowing students the opportunity to receive both high school and college credit simultaneously. High Schools interested in participating in the Dual Enrollment program for their students have signed working agreements ([Glenwood High School](#), [Lee County High School](#), [Central High School](#), and [Russell County High School](#)) with CVCC. As of fall semester 2012, two schools were participating in the Dual Enrollment Program with 32 enrolled students. Dual Enrollment high schools determine the equivalencies of CVCC courses toward high school graduation requirements. The [Dual Enrollment Coordinator](#) is responsible for reviewing the approved [courses](#), gathering [syllabi](#), and verifying [faculty credentials](#). At the end of each semester, division chairs review [portfolios](#) of student work to ensure the course work meets CVCC’s expected competencies and requirements. Dual enrollment courses provide educational opportunities for high school students in keeping with CVCC’s [mission](#) of “providing accessible and affordable education of excellent quality.”
