Narrative:

Chattahoochee Valley Community College (CVCC) evaluates success with respect to student achievement consistent with its [mission](#). A portion of the CVCC mission statement states; “The College is dedicated to providing accessible and affordable education of excellent quality preparing students for transfer to senior colleges and universities, employment, or career advancement through associate degrees and certificate programs.” The [Report on Measures of Student Success](#), along with other [institutional](#) and [State reports](#), allows CVCC to monitor and evaluate student success in several academic areas. CVCC uses comparisons to State and national benchmarks, as well as comparison with peer institutions for the following areas.

Other areas of student success, such as [course completion](#), [employment rates](#), [employer satisfaction](#), are monitored through the College’s [online unit plans](#), [program reviews](#), [Fact Book](#), and [Perkins Report](#). Several of CVCC’s Standing Committees, such as Cabinet, Distance Education, and Student Success also review data and surveys making recommendations for improvements as noted in [CS3.3.1 \(New Face for the Fortieth, Orientation Updates\)](#). Information provided by senior colleges and universities is also reviewed to see how CVCC transfer students are performing. A recent report from [Auburn University](#) indicates CVCC students compare equally with all transfers to Auburn for Fall 2011 with a GPA of 2.64 and performing better than all transfers Spring 2012 with a GPA of 2.79 compared to all transfer with a 2.67.
