**GUIDELINES FOR POLICY  
304.01: FINANCIAL REPORTING**

- I. For the purposes of this section, the term “Special Populations,” in the context of funds appropriated by the State of Alabama, shall hereafter include:
  - A. Individuals with disabilities;
  - B. Individuals from economically disadvantaged families, including foster children;
  - C. Individuals preparing for nontraditional training and employment;
  - D. Single parents, including single pregnant women;
  - E. Displaced homemakers;
  - F. Individuals with other barriers to educational achievement, including individuals with limited English proficiency;
  - G. Individuals who are incarcerated or on parole; and
  - H. Individuals who are in the first generation of their families to attend a college.
  - I. Individuals who need education or training for employment entry and/or advancement.
- II. “Special Population” grants may be made for adult education, pre-employment skills training, and short-term intensive career technical training.
