For the purpose of assisting the State Board of Education in carrying out its authority and responsibility for the Alabama Community College System, the State Board of Education shall have the authority to appoint a Chancellor who will also be chief executive officer of the Department of Postsecondary Education. The Chancellor shall serve at the pleasure of the State Board of Education and perform such duties as assigned by the State Board of Education; provided, however, that the State Board of Education may enter into a contract with the Chancellor for services for a period not to exceed four years. The Chancellor shall be a person of good moral character with academic and professional education equivalent to graduation from a recognized university or college, who is knowledgeable in postsecondary institution administration, and has training and experience sufficient to qualify him/her to perform the duties of the office.
