1. Please print and read your **MyMathLab Course Letter** found under "Course Information". Read your letter carefully.
2. You will need to view the **Course-Access (Orientation) video** in "Course Access". Please disregard the semester mentioned in the video and the dates if any. You can print out the PowerPoint presentation as well.
3. Complete the **Course-Access Test** that is found under "Course Access". You must complete the test before the deadline of **JANUARY 16, 2013 at 9:00 PM ET**. If not, you will be turned in as a No Show to the Admissions, Business, and Financial Aid offices. No show means that you will permanently be removed from the course and you will not receive your Pell check from the Business office.
4. After completing the Course-Access Test, you need to open the **Student Responsibility Contract**, complete it, and send to me via BLACKBOARD by **JANUARY 16, 2013**. Go to "Tools", click "Messages", then follow the instructions. In the Subject line please put "Student Responsibility Contract". Please make sure you save it to your computer, fill it out, save it, and then send to me. If you submit it to me by the deadline you will receive five additional points to your Course-Access Test.
5. We will be using **MyMathLab** that accompanies the book for our on-line course. If you purchase a textbook make sure you have the MyMathLab kit as well. You do not have to purchase the textbook. You can purchase just the MyMathLab kit on the website below or at the bookstore. MyMathLab has an electronic version of the book online. **All homework and tests will be completed on MyMathLab.**
6. To get started, please log onto the following website and register, www.pearsonmylabandmastering.com. You must register by **JANUARY 16, 2013** or you will be dropped from the course. Use your course letter to help you register and enroll into the course. Please use the access code that is located in the MyMathLab kit and the Course ID number is located on the course letter (it is my last name followed by five digits for ex. junghans12345).
