### Documentation of Related Experience

Captain Slouchick is currently serving as the Captain of the Special Operations Unit. He supervises 22 personnel and is the Commander of the unit. His unit is responsible for investigating drug activity, prostitution, and various vice operations within the city of Columbus, GA. He started his career in 1976 as a police officer, working a beat in various areas of the city. He has been promoted several times, serving as a detective, sergeant, lieutenant, and captain. His previous assignments have included investigating crimes against persons (i.e. homicides, rapes, armed robbery), supervisor investigators and patrol officers. As a lieutenant, Captain Slouchick supervised investigators, sergeants, and civilian personnel for crimes against persons and property. Captain Slouchick has special duties to the department including assignment as the Assistant S.W.A.T. Team Commander. He is a certified state law enforcement instructor (Police Officer Standard and Training Council) and has previous instructor experience at the Georgia Police Academy. Captain Slouchick is a graduate of the Georgia Chiefs of Police College, Leadership Columbus, and the F.B.I. National Academy in Quantico, VA.
